



Report of the Cleveland Police and Crime Commissioner to Chair and Members of the Cleveland Police and Crime Panel

Decisions made by the Police and Crime Commissioner – 17 September 2024- 1st November 2024

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide Cleveland Police and Crime Panel (PCP) with an update on decisions made by the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) since the last meeting.
- 1.2 This report also provides a forward plan which forms part of the PCCs planning and scrutiny programme.

2. Background

- 2.1 The PCC makes all decisions unless specifically delegated within the Scheme of Consent/Delegation. All decisions demonstrate that they are soundly based on relevant information and that the decision-making process is open and transparent.
- 2.2 In addition, a forward plan is included which includes items requiring a decision in the future. This is attached at Appendix 1 of the report.
- 2.3 Each decision made by the PCC is recorded on a decision record form with supporting background information appended (as necessary). Once approved it is published on the PCC website.
- 2.4 Decisions relating to private/confidential matters will be recorded; although, it may be appropriate that full details are not published.

3. Decisions of the Police and Crime Commissioner

- 3.1 Decisions made since the last meeting of the Police and Crime Panel are listed in Appendix 2.

4. Implications
